The Pomperaug Health District offers the most protective flu vaccines currently on the market. Vaccines are administered by experienced, licensed nurses.

Available Vaccines

Quadrivalent flu vaccine \$30

For persons 6 months and older • the “regular” flu shot

FluMist Vaccine \$30**

For persons 2 - 49 years • the nasal spray vaccine

Flublok vaccine* \$65

For persons 18 years and older • For adults with egg allergy

*available only at the weekly Pomperaug Health District office clinics

High-Dose vaccine \$65

For persons 65 years and older

Studies have shown that the high-dose flu vaccine is safe and more effective for seniors than the regular flu shot
